Homework Policy

With a few exceptions, assignments will be due the day after they are assigned. We will use up to 10 minutes of class time to go over questions you may have on an assignment. If you have more than one or two questions, you will need to come see me outside of class. If there is a situation that makes it impossible for you to get your assignment in on time, you need to let me know ahead of time. No late assignments are accepted.

Homework Grades

Homework must be neat with ALL work shown (unless otherwise stated). All homework scores are out of 5 points. On most homework, I will grade 4 questions. Each question is worth 1 point and a complete assignment will earn you another point.

Homework is to be done in pencil. NO PENS!!!

Make-up work should be completed as quickly as possible. After an absence, it is your responsibility to see me about the work you missed.

All tests will be announced approximately one week in advance. Quizzes may be unannounced.

Only 1 pass out of class is allowed per week. (You must have your assignment book in order to leave the classroom.)

Retakes

You may retake a test if you are not satisfied with your grade. All homework for the unit must be completed before you retake the test. You must retake the test within one week of the original test date.
